

The Brain—Health Professionals

Each Treatment Centre has a range of services to provide assistance when a brain tumour is diagnosed. Listed below are some of the professionals available at treatment centres.

Inquire about a referral & appointments —In the Public Health Centres these services <u>may be freely available</u>

- Neuro-surgeon (a Doctor) surgically removes the tumour
- Neurologist (a Doctor) who specializes in the diagnosis and treatment of disorders of the nervous system
- Radiation Oncologist (a Doctor) Treats the tumour or any residual tumour with radiation therapy
- Medical Oncologist (a Doctor) Treats the tumour or any residual tumour with chemotherapy
- Neuro-Oncologist A Medical Oncologist specialising in the treatment of tumours of the central nervous system (CNS)]
- Radiation Therapist Delivers the actual radiation therapy treatment to the patient by the use of a device called a linear accelerator
- Social Worker Provides counselling, resources & education for the patient, and family including children. Makes community service referrals, and liaises with agencies eg Centrelink on patients behalf
- Speech Pathologist Provides strategies to assist with difficulties with language and swallowing
- **Physiotherapist** Assists with exercise plans and physical therapies to maximise mobility
- Occupational Therapist Assists with assessment and equipment to maximise independence
- **Dietician** Assists with weight loss, weight gain, and all associated dietary problems including concerns about diabetics in relation to the use of Medications as well as advise on balancing a nutritional intake of food
- Neuro-psychologist Provides neuro/cognitive function assessments & strategies to assist with behaviour modification therapies and possible return to work
- Psycho-oncologist See Above
- Clinical Trials Coordinator (sometimes called a Data manager) coordinates clinical trials of particular types of treatments eg chemotherapy's and

radiation therapy to treat tumours
